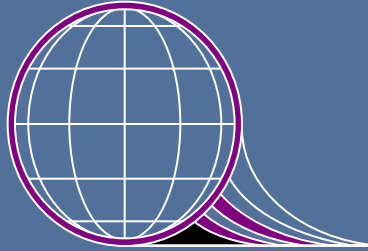

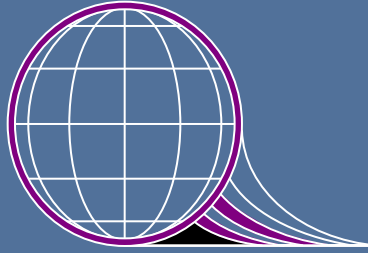
Damage Prevention: Why Does It Concern Pipeline Operators?

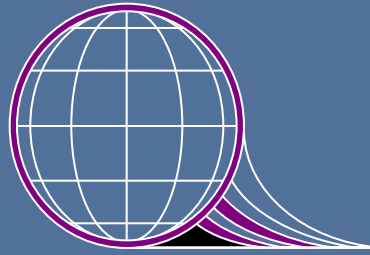
Why is Effective Damage Prevention Important?

- External interference was the cause of six failure incidents and 40 damage incidents (no release of service fluid) on CEPA pipelines during the period 2002-2009
- External interference was the fourth most common cause of failures
- All CEPA external interference failures during the period 2002-2009 were caused by third parties



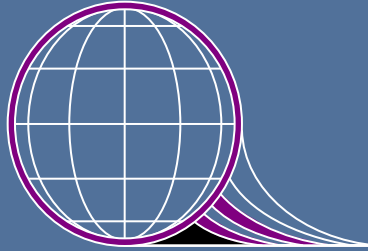
Why is Effective Damage Prevention Important?

Prevention of external interference is considered to be a high priority because of the potential for personal injury and death to the people who are present when the failure occurs



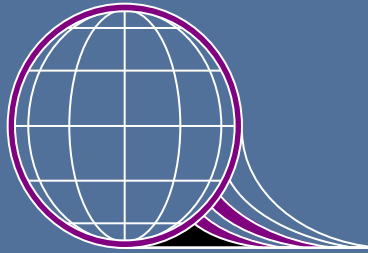
Why is Effective Damage Prevention Important?
